## LESSON 2: RESIZING IMAGES

Resizing is an important skill for image editing because usually images are not at the same size as you like. There are several ways to do it. I will only show two ways to you.

## I. Way

1) Open an image from Blackboard under Content My picture's URL: Blackboard/Content/Resizing an Image

2) Click to the Image Button on the upper panel, then press Image Size

3) A board should come out which asks you the Width and Height of the new image and there is a box which helps to change it properly. You may unchecked the box near it but, the quality of the image will break down. The current size of my image is $468 \times 600$ and I will change it to $960 \times 1231$ (computer suggested the height according to the new width)


## II. Way

1) Click to Edit button over the black stripe on the upper part of the site. Afterwards, click the Free Transform (Shortcut: CTRL + T)

2) Then use the blue boxes to expand and narrow the image size.

3) After narrowing the image size background will be white as a frame. To remove this use technique that you learned in the first lesson. (Crop Tool)
