## S.M.A.R. T. Lunch Procedure & Incentive

## **English I Honors**

SMART lunch opportunities are available every Wednesday (B Half) and Friday (A Half).

SMART lunch provides time to:

Work on assignments

Collaborate with peers

Receive additional instruction or clarity

Make up any work missed All students are expected to attend a minimum of 4 tutorials per quarter. It is encouraged that students attend 2 prior to interim and 2 after.

> Students may be required to attend additional tutorials as deemed necessary by the teacher. Any SMART lunch assigned by the teacher is mandatory. Failure to attend an assigned mandatory SMART lunch is a disciplinary infraction.

## Procedures:

- 1. Upon arriving in the classroom, it is the student's responsibility to sign in on the designated teacher roster. Locate name and initial under the correct date.
- 2. Students must then record the date attended on their personal tutorial log.
- 3. When the bell rings for dismissal, students must have their personal log signed by the teacher.
- \*\*No credit will be given if both logs are not signed- one by the student, the other by the teacher.
- \*\*Students must be present for the entire time to receive credit. Students who arrive late or leave early will not receive credit.
- \*\*English I students are expected to work on English I material/assignments during the session to receive credit. Simply being present does not qualify.

INCENTIVE: Students who attend 4 SMART lunches and maintain all classroom expectations will earn an extra 100 as a minor assessment grade which carries a 35% grade weight each quarter. Research proves students who utilize SMART lunch earn higher grades.
