

CHARACTER

A character is a **person** (or personified object or animal) in a literary work.

Types of characters:

- **FLAT** (STATIC) characters are minor characters who do not undergo substantial change or growth in the course of a story.
- **ROUND** (DYNAMIC) characters are those who encounter conflict and are changed by it. Round characters tend to be more fully developed and described.
