- 1) Define the word "Reich."
- 2) How did Charlemagne come to power? Why was he considered important to German (& French) history?
- 3) Define constitutional monarchy?
- 4) How did Otto von Bismark come to power?
- 5) List 3 good things and 3 bad things about the Second Reich.
- 6) Describe the impact the Treaty of Versailles had upon the German economy and military.
- 7) In the German Constitution: what is Article 48? What is good about having this policy? What is a danger for having this type of policy?
- 8) What hardships did Hitler face as a young child? How do you think they shaped him as he grew up?
- 9) What beliefs did the Nazi Party get from previous Reichs? What was the main goal of the Nazis party?
- 10) What are concentration camps? What was their original purpose?
- 11) Why did the Nazis care about education? What did they do about it?
- 12) What impact did the Nuremberg Laws & Krystallnacht have upon the Jewish population of Germany?
- 13) Create a list of Hitler's positive accomplishments by 1938, at the height of his popularity. Which accomplishment do you feel was most impressive? Explain.
- 14) What problem had developed in Germany during by 1938? How could they solve this problem? Would you have made the same choice? Explain.
- 15) What was Lebensraum? What was the problem with getting this "Lebensraum" in Poland?
- 16) On the Back: Pretend that Hitler had a Twitter account during his lifetime and was tweeting during the major moments in his life. Create a Twitter Timeline of at least 7 Tweets that encompass his early life, time during WWI, and post-WWI life.
 - a. A "tweet" cannot be more than 140 characters, including punctuation and spaces.
 - b. Example:

August 25, 1913- Enjoyed Wagner's Opera for the 23rd straight night. #LivingTheMunichGoodLife
(This is 76 characters, including spaces)
